

Announcement for Executive Director of the Community Food Bank of Grand Junction:

The Community Food Bank of Grand Junction has been committed to feeding those in need in Mesa County for almost forty years. Our mission is to provide nutritious food to individuals and families in crisis. There are no income qualifications or other restrictions on who is eligible to receive emergency food. Clients may receive an emergency food box up to nine times a year. The CFB is located in Grand Junction at 562 W Crete Circle Suite 102 during the following hours: Monday 1pm to 3 pm, Tuesday 10 am to noon and 1 pm to 3 pm, Thursday 1 pm to 3 pm and 5 pm to 7 pm, Friday 10 am to noon. The Food Bank is closed Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday.

The Community Food Bank is the only program to provide unrestricted access to food 52 weeks per year. No one is turned away.

The Executive Director manages the daily operation of the food bank, trains, schedules and supervises all 40 volunteers, orders and coordinates all food deliveries, and works closely with the 11 volunteer board of directors in establishing the budget, conducting outreach efforts, participating in community events and promoting the needs of the CFB to the Mesa County community.
